Important - Please note! **WATER LINE FLUSHING IN APRIL**

The Town of Coupeville will be flushing water mains as routine maintenance starting April 8, 2008 and ending April 10, 2008. The flushing process will take place Tuesday through Thursday during the hours 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Central Whidbey Fire & Rescue will be testing fire hydrants as routine maintenance starting April 14, 2008 and ending April 18, 2008. This work will take place Monday through Friday during the hours 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The purpose of water main flushing is to remove iron and manganese sediment that entered the distribution system from the well sources and settled within the mains.

During the flushing and hydrant testing, the water in the mains may become turbid (dirty looking). The turbid water is not hazardous to health, but may cause such aesthetic problems as staining laundry. We suggest you refrain from doing laundry during the flushing hours and be prepared that some of the first water out of the tap may be dirty looking. Running the faucet for a few seconds should clear the line.
