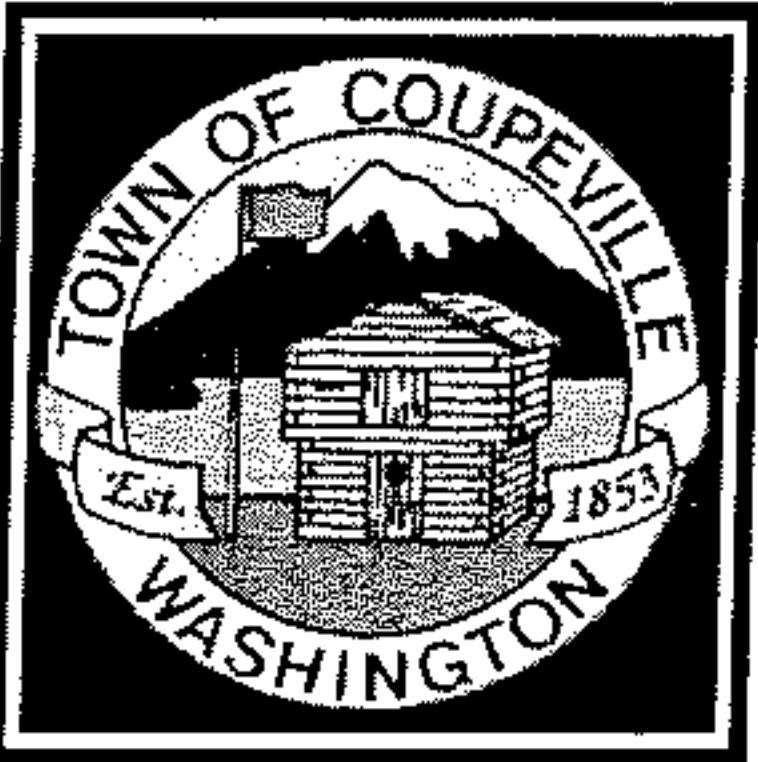

### NOTICE TO WATER CUSTOMERS

The Town of Coupeville will be flushing water mains as routine maintenance starting October 14, 2008 and ending October 17, 2008. The flushing process will take place Tuesday through Friday during the hours 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The purpose of water main flushing is to remove iron and manganese sediment that entered the distribution system from the well sources and settled within the mains. Individual prior notice of daily flushing activities will not be given.

During the flushing the water in the mains may become turbid (dirty looking). The turbid water is not hazardous to health, but may cause aesthetic problems such as staining laundry. We suggest you refrain from doing laundry during the flushing hours and be prepared that some of the first water out of the tap may be dirty looking. Running the faucet for a few seconds should clear the line.
